Tax fraud has been rampant, especially the practice of improperly claiming child dependents so;

<u>Please bring, or email verification that your child lived with you.</u> (This document needs to have your child's name and your current address because we cannot get you a \$2,000 child tax credit without verification!)


For TY 2023 the credit for <u>Energy Efficient Home Improvement</u> is 30% of the cost of certain types of exterior doors, windows, insulation, central AC, water heaters, furnaces, boilers, and heat pumps. There is now an annual credit limit of \$1200.

The credit for <u>Residential Clean Energy</u> is 30% of the cost of solar, wind and geothermal power generation, solar water heaters, fuel cells, and battery storage. There is no annual maximum or lifetime limit.

Standard deductions are higher for TY 2023. Married couples get \$27,700 plus \$1,850 for each spouse 65 or older. Singles can claim \$13,850...\$15,700 if age 65 or up. Heads of household get \$20,800 plus \$1,850 once they reach 65. Blind people receive \$1,850 more.

The standard Mileage rate for business driving is higher this year. The rate is 65.5 ¢ per mile for TY 2023.
